





At the end of Term 2, TheirCare families received an expression of interest form for our Takeaway Food Program, a new initiative program that TheirCare has introduced, and we will be trialing throughout Term 3. TC Takeaway is a cooking club with a twist, families will take home nutritious, vegan and allergy conscious meals prepared by the children at after-school-care. TC takeaway is a fun and enriching activity that teaches important food preparation and cooking skills, along with building an understanding of healthy eating.
