It is important that we try to keep the length of meetings to a reasonable amount of time and to make eligibility and funding processes to be as efficient as possible.

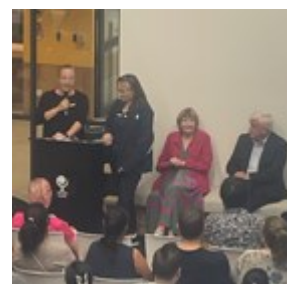
We need to be sure that the important issues that need to be measured are those that will lead to being able to participate in Emerson School's outstanding learning programs.

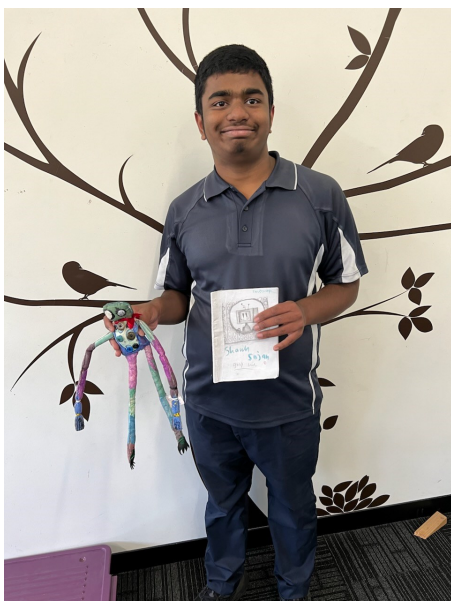
All Emersonians have rights and responsibilities to achieve safety, cooperation, self-control, order and learning.
